THE VERNON COUNTY COMMISSION MET PURSUANT TO ADJOURNMENT ON WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 5, 2011 AT 9:00 A.M.

PRESENT: BONNIE M. MCCORD, PRESIDING COMMISSIONER, NEAL F. GERSTER, NORTHERN COMMISSIONER AND KENNON R. SHAW, SOUTHERN COMMISSIONER.

CLOSED SESSION

Commissioner Gerster made motion at 9:14 A.M. to go into Closed Session per RSMo 610.021(1). Commissioner McCord seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Gerster (Yes); Commissioner McCord (Yes); Commissioner Shaw (Abstain).

Also those in attendance were Vernon County Prosecuting Attorney, Lynn M. Ewing, III and Vernon County Clerk, Tammi Beach. No votes were taken.

Commissioner Gerster made motion to go back into Open Session at 9:43 A.M. Commissioner McCord seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Gerster (Yes); Commissioner McCord (Yes); Commissioner Shaw (Abstain).

MONTEVALLO TOWNSHIP ISSUES

Wesley Stoles, Helen Mangers, and Elvie Mangers called on the Commission to discuss road accessing their property in Montevallo Township, Section 35, formerly known as the community of Zodiac. Commission finds the road in question has never been closed by petition through the County Commission. Commissioner Gerster researched the property at the Assessor and GIS office. Commission made appointment to meet with landowners Tuesday, October 11, 2011 at 2:00 P.M. at Montevallo Township, Section 35 on Zodiac Road.

Later in the day Mrs. Mangers informed the Commission, by phone, that the property tax information she received in 1999 and 2000 showed acreage, and not lots, in the community of Zodiac that she had received in previous assessments.

MISSOURI TRAPPERS ASSOCIATION

Rob Page, representing the Missouri Trappers Association, telephoned the Commission for availability and rental information for use of the Fairgrounds in 2012.

ROAD MAINTENANCE

Debbie Bossaller telephoned the Commission with a question "If 2000 Road is being maintained by the township, is it open to public travel?". Commissioner Shaw advised Ms. Bossaller if the road is being maintained by the township it should be a public road.

Vernon County Emergency Management Director, Dennis Kimrey, called on the Commission to discuss plumbing issues in the upstairs of the EOC Building.

PUBLIC ADMINISTRATOR ISSUES

Vernon County Public Administrator, Tammy Bond, called on the Commission requesting budget amendment to allow an extra \$2,200.00 (180 hours) for part time help due to the Hab Center closing, and her clients being moved out of County, requiring additional work.

Commissioner Shaw made a motion to increase part time help 180 hours for Public Administrator Office and amend budget \$2,200.00 for additional expense. Commissioner Gerster seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Shaw (Yes); Commissioner Gerster (Yes); Commissioner McCord (Yes).

SHERIFF DEPARTMENT ISSUES

Commission spoke with Vernon County Sheriff, Ron Peckman, and CNET Officer for clarification of grant awards for budget amendment. Commission requested a letter of commitment by CNET for the 25% match award not covered by the grant.

Also discussed LAGERS benefits have not been included in the grant request as a reimbursable item, and Commission was informed the grant can be modified to reflect the LAGERS expense.

Commission reported to the Sheriff's office damage to a window on the ground floor. Later in the day John Randall, Investigator, called on the Commission for more information.

Commission received correspondence from US Department of Justice with regard to COPS Grant #2007CKWX0265, ORI: MO10900. Same was forwarded to Vernon County Sheriff, Ron Peckman.

KAYSINGER BASIN REGIONAL PLANNING COMMISSION

Commission spoke with Austin Mount, Director, Kaysinger Basin Regional Planning Commission, with questions regarding the Brownfield Study. Mr. Mount was recently informed the host county may not make application for funds.

REGION M SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT DISTRICT

Commission e-mailed Vernon County Preliminary Grant Application to Region M Solid Waste Management District for the 2012 Grant Cycle in the amount of \$18,000.00 for labor expenses at the Recycling Center. Commission received confirmation of receipt of this grant application.
