Fairgrounds

Permission was given and she was asked to contact the University of Extension office to schedule the date. She was informed proof of liability insurance was needed prior to the event.

Metz Township Issues

Gwen Jones, Representative, Farm Bureau Insurance Services, called on Commission with regard to collapsed bridge in Metz Township, Section 20. Settlement agreement was presented, approved and check received in the amount of \$47,210.92.
