THE VERNON COUNTY COMMISSION MET PURSUANT TO ADJOURNMENT, ON WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 18, 2010, AT 9:00 A.M.

Fence Laws

Dan Garrett, landowner in Vernon County, called the Commission requesting information for fence laws and a road in Clear Creek Township, Section 25. After review Commission believes this to be an open public road, and referred him to 228.190 RSMo.

Drywood Township Issues

Drywood Township Board Member, John Zoglmann, called on the Commission regarding CART contract. He was informed the March 17th start date for contracts had been moved back to March 1st to allow rock and rock hauling tickets to be used during that time period. CART contract start date was moved to March 1, 2010 to accommodate Ash Grove Aggregates offer of reduced rate on rock from the old El Dorado Quarry.
