THE VERNON COUNTY COMMISSION MET PURSUANT TO ADJOURNMENT ON TUESDAY,, NOVEMBER 22, 2011 AT 9:00 A.M.

PRESENT: BONNIE M. MCCORD, PRESIDING COMMISSIONER; AND NEAL F. GERSTER, NORTHERN COMMISSIONER.

CLOSED SESSION

Commissioner McCord made a motion to add a Closed Session, per RSMo 610.021(1), to the agenda for 2:30 P.M. Commissioner Gerster seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner McCord (Yes); Commissioner Gerster (Yes).

PERSONNEL

Vernon County GIS Director, Tim Bourassa, called on Commission and asked to be off Wednesday, the 23rd. Commission granted request.

INSURANCE

Jeff Post, Morrison Post Insurance was contacted regarding credit not received by the County for the jail following inspection by the Insurance Inspector. Mr. Post will research and get back with Commission next week.

VIRGIL TOWNSHIP ISSUES

Bill Clevenger, Virgil Township, Section 3, telephoned the Commission regarding hole in road. Commission inspected. Road & Bridge Foreman, Ron Sloan, was contacted

EXTENSION COUNCIL

Tom Harold, the Extension Council President, reported the Women's restroom in the Home Ec Building is running continuously.

SHERIFF DEPARTMENT ISSUES

Commissioner Gerster made motion to approve Award of Contract to continue the 2009-10-EUDL-21 grant. Commissioner McCord seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Gerster (Yes); Commissioner McCord (Yes); Commissioner Shaw (Absent).

VIRGIL TOWNSHIP ISSUES

Vernon County Bridge Foreman, Ron Sloan, reported on the hole in the road in Virgil Township, Section 3 he believes it to be a township culvert. Commission notified Virgil Township Board Member, Wesley Greenstreet. Later he informed the Commission he will repair with culvert. Commission spoke with Barbara York, Virgil Township Trustee, and she will present to the Board for possible upgrade at Township's expense for the culvert, and the County will install and maintain following drainage review.

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ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

City of Nevada IT Director, Mark Mitchell, telephoned the Commission requesting Letter of Compliance for the Economic Development.

ROADS

Commission returned call to David Bennett, Magellan Pipeline, regarding repairs on Missouri roads (2975 and HH Highway).

RECYCLING CENTER

J. D. Kehrman, Nevada City Manager, met with the Commission regarding revenue for the Vernon County Recycling Center not being deposited in the County fund for use for recycling expenses and salaries. Mr. Kehrman will investigate with Finance Department regarding assets that have been deposited with the City. He was informed the outstanding payroll for 2011 is \$5,696.49, and the revenues not received by the County are \$10,043.36.

Ralph Pokorny, Nevada Daily Mail, and questioned the Commission regarding outcome of votes taken during the closed session. He was informed the Closed Session was not held.

MoDOT

Commission received copy of e-mail from Darin Hamelink, P.E., Area Engineer, MoDOT, to Jason Eckhardt, Sprenkle & Associates, Inc. advising BRO-B108(38) plans have been submitted to FHWA for approval.

Mr. Hamelink also advised bridge structure just South of Whitworth Road is under 20 feet and is not on inventory. Bridge #6250033 is North of Whitworth Road and is classified as a bridge built in 1905 and is a pony truss.

GOVERNMENTAL COOPERATIVE CONTRACT

Commission received Governmental Cooperative Contract from the City of Metz for services associated with the 2011 real estate and personal properties tax billings, along with check in the amount of \$29.40.
