REPORTS

Commission approved County Clerk report for November, 2011.

Commission approved payroll and payroll benefits checks.

MAPPING

Mark Mitchell, IT Director, City of Nevada, called on the Commission requesting paper map with 911 addresses for the Fire Department. Commission is requesting specific information for clarification, in writing, and acknowledged by the City Manager.

CENTER TOWNSHIP ISSUES

Commissioner Gerster reported on a call he received from John Shorten regarding issue with an outer road in Center Township, Section 36, with question of maintenance when I-49 becomes an interstate. He was informed Commission would check with MoDOT for plans and would visit with Center Township Board.

INSPECTIONS
