WESTERN MISSOURI 911 DISPATCH CENTER

Commission spoke with WM911 Dispatch Center Director, Richard Roark, with regard to 2012 911 budget and request for County share to be the same as 2011 in the amount of \$179,000.00. By Commission's calculation of percentage of calls, as contract states, County's at 28.4%, which includes all rural volunteer fire departments, appropriations should be \$158,188.00.

RECYCLING CENTER

Commission received response to County's Sunshine Law request from the City of Nevada regarding missing revenues from the Recycling Center, which, since inception, has been deposited in the Recycling Center Fund account with the Vernon County Treasurer for operation expenses of the Recycling Center. According to the response from the City of Nevada these funds, totaling \$14,014.87, have been deposited to the City account without Vernon County's knowledge or authorization.
