THE VERNON COUNTY COMMISSION MET PURSUANT TO ADJOURNMENT ON THURSDAY, JANUARY 5, 2012 AT 9:00 A.M.

SHERIFF BUDGET

Commission met with Vernon County Sheriff, Ron Peckman, and Pete Schmidt, Sheriff's office with regard to budget.

Commission left message for budget estimates for Sprenkle & Associates, Inc., and Harrington & Cortelyou, Inc. regarding BRO bridge projects.
