THE VERNON COUNTY COMMISSION METPURSUANT TO ADJOURNMENT ON TUESDAY, JANUARY 10, 2012 AT 9:00 A.M.

PRESENT: BONNIE M. MCCORD, PRESIDING COMMISSIONER; NEAL F. GERSTER, NORTHERN COMMISSIONER; AND KENNON R. SHAW, SOUTHERN COMMISSIONER.

COAL TOWNSHIP ISSUES

Andy Mueller, Assistant District Engineer Operations, MoDOT, contacted the Commission regarding the old section of 54 Highway in Coal Township, Section 6. MoDOT has acceptance of roadway by the township Board in the 1950s, however MoDOT is not finding it was ever recorded, and therefore they are beginning the process again.

BRIDGE DEPARTMENT ISSUES

Lynn Seaver, Bridge Department called on the Commission for ongoing road and bridge matters.

GIS ISSUES

J. J. Curtis, Jime Earnest, Monte Curtis, Vernon County GIS Director, Tim Bourassa; and Vernon County Assessor, Cherie Roberts met with Commissioners to discuss GIS information available online with a subscription fee. Mr. Bourassa gave overview explaining what would be offered in the future.

SHERIFF DEPARTMENT ISSUES

Pete Schmidt, Sheriff's office, presented to the Commission quarterly reimbursement for signature on MOSMART grant in the amount of \$23,936.30 for a total grant of \$84,992.00.

Commission approved Award of Contract and Certified Assurance document pertaining to 2012-DSSSF-062 (Deputy Sheriff Salary Supplementation Fund Program) grant.

CLEAR CREEK TOWNSHIP ISSUES

Clear Creek Township Board Member, Perry Lackey, telephoned Commission to clarify boundary roads which Clear Creek was to maintain. He also asked if brushcutter had left his township.

CENTER TOWNSHIP ISSUES

Justin Meyer requested information regarding a road in Center Township, Section 20, Quarter Master Road, as to whether it is a public or private road.

INSURANCE

Jeff Post, Morrison Post Insurance, presented refund check to the Commission for insurance at the jail in the amount of \$1,200.00, and informed the Commission the cost for insurance at the 911 Center is \$1,800.00 annually, and would be itemized in future billings.

PERSONNEL

Discussion was held regarding part time employee becoming full time. It was determined the six month introductory period would still pertain with the County health insurance.

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REPORTS

Commission approved Recorder of Deeds report for December, 2011.

PLANNING & ZONING ISSUES

Commission received request from TFS& Associates, LLC with regard to planning and zoning issues. Response was made advising the County does not have zoning and planning law in place, however State and Federal laws may apply.
