THE VERNON COUNTY COMMISSION MET, PURSUANT TO ADJOURNMENT, ON THURSDAY, JANUARY 12, 2012 AT 9:00 A.M.

PRESENT: BONNIE M. MCCORD, PRESIDING COMMISSIONER; NEAL F. GERSTER, NORTHERN COMMISSIONER; AND KENNON R. SHAW, SOUTHERN COMMISSIONER.

WESTERN MISSOURI 911 DISPATCH CENTER

Richard Roark, WM911DC Director, J. D. Kehrman as Chairperson for WM911DC, Vernon County Sheriff, Ron Peckman, and Rusty Murry, Reporter, Nevada Daily Mail, called on the Commission to discuss the Commission's consideration of funding the shortage in the amount of \$7,657.01 to the 2012 911 Budget. Also requested the County pay the \$1,800.00 equipment insurance expense and have Vernon County IT Director, Tim Bourassa, do updates to save 911 an additional \$1,200.00. Mr. Bourassa was consulted at this time.

The County agreed to pay the equipment insurance expense and to have County IT Director make updates to save 911 \$1,200.00; however it is believed the shortfall should be divided between the City and the County. Commission agreed to pay 40% which would be \$3,062.81, and noted that the 911's shortfall is due to the City's non-payment, as contract states, their proportional share of the expense. The request was for the County to fully fund the budget shortfall for 2012.
