THE VERNON COUNTY COMMISSION MET, PURSUANT TO ADJOURNMENT, ON WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 1, 2012 AT 9:00 A.M

DNR – TIRE COLLECTION

Commission spoke with Mona McDowell, landowner, Deerfield Township, Section 4, regarding the DNR tire collection scheduled in September. Later in the day Mrs. McDowell came into Commission's office and spoke by phone with Richard Allen, DNR, to schedule the collection event. He required copy of the property deeds. SHERIFF
