THE VERNON COUNTY COMMISSION MET, PURSUANT TO ADJOURNMENT, ON WEDNESDAY, APRIL 17, 2013 AT 9:00 A.M.

CENTER TOWNSHIP

Monte Curtis and J. J. Curtis, Curtis & Sons Real Estate, called on Commission for determination of road in Center Township, Section 3, East of the Vernon County Sheriff's Office, connecting to MAC Boulevard. Commission believes road is County road.

COURT HOUSE SECURITY
