City of Nevada IT Director, Mark Mitchell, and City of Nevada Planning Manager, Johnna Williams, along with Vernon County Assessor, Cherie Roberts, and Vernon County GIS Director, Tim Bourassa, called on the Commission requesting the use of the Blue Line Maps in the Assessor's office.
