Report

Commission approved County Clerk report for May, 2011.

Brushcutter

Commission received Walker Township map marked where brushcutting is needed by the County brushcutter.

Emergency Management

Vernon County Emergency Management Director, Dennis Kimrey, telephoned the Commission with information he had received regarding the EMP grant that Federal funds will not be released until August or September for the first quarter reimbursement, and discussed new requirements of the grant. 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Recorder of Deeds Issues

Vernon County Recorder of Deeds, Doug Shupe, called on the Commission requesting employee Shelly Baldwin be allowed to carry over seven hours unused vacation time for sixty days. Commission approved this request.

Prairie Pride - ADM

Commission contacted Attorney, Deborah Polk, Armstrong Teasdale, for progress update of changes to Consent and Estoppels Certificates. She informed the Commission the Addendum will be forthcoming for Commission's review on Tuesday, June 7th, and the payment in lieu of for 2010 will be paid approximately June 10th.

MoDOT

Becky Baltz, District Engineer, MoDOT, met with Commission regarding lay-off and cutbacks by MoDOT. Also in attendance were Missouri State Representative, Barney Fisher; Austin Mount, Director, and Samantha Dingfelder, Kaysinger Basin Regional Planning Commission; as well as other concerned citizens from the area.

Commission also discussed former MoDOT bridge on outer road in Washington Township, Section 9, and provided a copy of the MoDOT Bridge Inventory and Inspection, Inventory # 2290013. Commission is requesting MoDOT's assistance for this bridge as it pertains to the I-49 upgrade.

Moundville Township Issues

Commission received NRCS map of Moundville Township, Section 29 from the NRCS as it pertains to request from Moundville Township to upgrade a culvert by the County. The NRCS map shows drainage area of 25 acres and does not meet the minimum requirement. Commission will so inform the township this is a township responsibility.

Outer Road - Drywood Township

Barbara Householder called on the Commission regarding outer road near her place of business in Drywood Township, Section 3 as it pertains to the I-49 Project. She was given contact information for MoDOT for clarification of road closures work to be done.
