

Kaysinger Basin RPC Safe Streets for All

Safety Action Plan Facts

The Safe Streets for All (SS4A) planning grant is being administered by Kaysinger Basin Regional Planning Commission on behalf of our 7-county region consisting of the following:

1. Bates County
2. Benton County
3. Cedar County
4. Henry County
5. Hickory County
6. St. Clair County
7. Vernon County

Phase One: Kaysinger will conduct community outreach in each county enlisting the help of municipalities and stakeholders to assist with surveying community members to gather input and data regarding areas of concern for vehicular and multi-modal transportation.

Phase Two: Kaysinger Basin RPC will enlist the assistance of the SS4A Committee who will consist of community members and stakeholders from each county to help determine top priority areas of concern in each county using the data from the surveys.

Phase Three: Kaysinger Basin RPC will propose evidence-based, high-impact, low-cost, and innovative solutions to achieve zero roadway fatalities and serious injuries in the top priority areas in each county. Once completed the proposed Safety Action Plan will be presented to the regional Transportation Advisory Committee (TAC) for discussion and feedback.

Phase Four: The final draft plan will be made available to local government officials and residents for feedback. Kaysinger Basin RPC will then craft a final version of the plan to be officially adopted as the Regional Safety Action Plan.

These efforts will result in a 20-year Safety Action Plan that has well defined strategies and a comprehensive approach toward preventing traffic fatalities and serious injuries in the Kaysinger Region by 2046. **It will be a critical tool that can be utilized by municipalities and counties to secure funding opportunities for project implementation.** It will serve as a baseline for safer regional transportation, and can be amended to include priority projects as they arise throughout the life of the plan.
